By encouraging a personal response to the presentation, our training reinforces the knowledge that accidents affect not only the individual, but also friends, family and work colleagues.

We also develop specific training modules with our partners to ensure that their current safety mechanisms are fulfilling their potential.

Fear To Tread (DVD) – *Shows how innocent mistakes can lead to tragic consequences.*

When your judgement lets you down, Fate steps in... but is she as innocent as she appears? A young girl tells of her experience of witnessing a simple error and reveals she may not have seen the full story.

Gail’s Shoes – *Reveals the true knock-on effect of a momentary lapse of attention.*

The story of a couple whose world has been turned upside-down as a result of twenty seconds of human error.

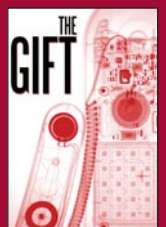
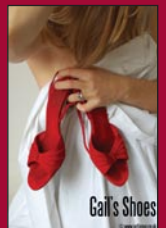
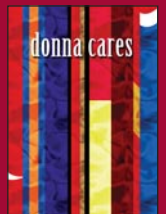
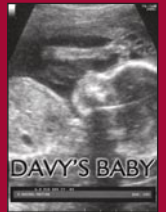
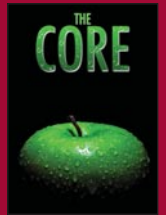

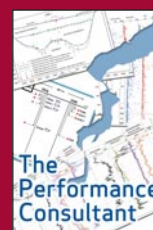
Open Mike – *1.5 hr training 'motivation' module incl actors & facilitators; up to 80 delegates*

Explores different character types and how they react to behavioural training, particularly with regard to intervention in the workplace. Followed by an amusing presentation of how we often know what we should do, but can be embarrassed to do so in reality.



The Performance Consultant – *Brings statistics to life.*

A powerpoint presentation collapses when the consultant giving the talk arrives at a slide on safety. Those statistics on the graphs and charts are more than numbers; fate has brought Paul Cunningham to the conference on a tragic anniversary. The audience reflects on the shock of his public breakdown.



Reversal (DVD) – *What would you do differently if you could turn back time?*

A terrifying sound announces a story presented as a series of flashbacks taking us to the point at which a decision was made; one that could change one man's destiny.



Tool Box Talk Live – *2 hour training module incl actors & facilitators; large/small groups.*

Gives delegates the chance to practice clear, engaging communication when presenting vital safety information at work.



The Vigil – *Messages come in all forms – as do warnings – and seductions.*

A powerful and disturbing monologue which questions our ability to see what's under the surface. Includes facilitation module which explores our personal relationship with risk.

A son films his father for his project 'life in the workplace.' We follow them as they get ready in the morning to travel to the office. Recognising the day-to-day hazards that we all deal with yet think nothing of, we see it can be the simplest event that can impact our lives.
